JULY 2012 Highlights

- 💧 Received initial approval from USACE to add the Board of Authority as an additional local sponsor (Design Agreement)
- 💧 FY 13 Workplan scenarios; alternatives to advance work
 - *Individual meetings with Boards and Commission*
- 💧 Continued to coordinate/facilitate JPA discussions, revised Design Agreement, and FY-13 Work-in-Kind Program
- 💧 Post-ROD studies, design decision process and outreach
- 💧 Regulatory agency meeting on July 18th to discuss mitigation projects/needs, flows through town, and ongoing field studies

JULY 2012 Highlights

- 💧 Issued request for permitting information from local, state, and federal regulatory agencies to begin Permitting Plan
- 💧 RFQ for property management firm services
- 💧 Hosted Transportation workshop with LSLCTT
- 💧 Participated in bridge design meetings for BNSF railroad, I-29, and CR-31, and preliminary design reviews of other transportation features
- 💧 Contributed to USACE Channel Constructability Value Engineering
