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# May/June Highlights - Technical

## 💧 Bridge Reaches

- *Design on CR-20 bridge – addressing review comments*

## 💧 OHB Levee

- *WP-43A – Change Order #1 (all 2014 work will be east of Hwy 81), Notice to Proceed (est. June 20), continued coordination with Oxbow development and golf course projects*
- *65% Design on WP-43B and 35% Design on WP-43C*
- *404 and ND SWC construction permit applications submitted and under review*

# May/June Highlights - Technical

- 💧 In-Town levees – 65% complete
  - *65% submittal - responding to review comments*
  - *Design work continuing on floodwalls and pump stations*
  - *Continued coordination with New City Hall project*
- 💧 Reach 5 Channel (USACE) – 65% review complete
- 💧 Wild Rice Dam Fish Passage Mitigation (USACE) - 65% submittal review started

# May/June Highlights – Other Activities

- 💧 WRRDA bill - signed June 10
- 💧 MN EIS - ongoing
- 💧 Continued work on land acquisition activities and policies
- 💧 Cemetery Assessment Team – USACE draft study

# June/July Priority Areas

- 💧 OHB Levee
