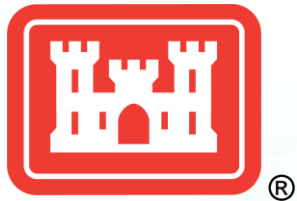

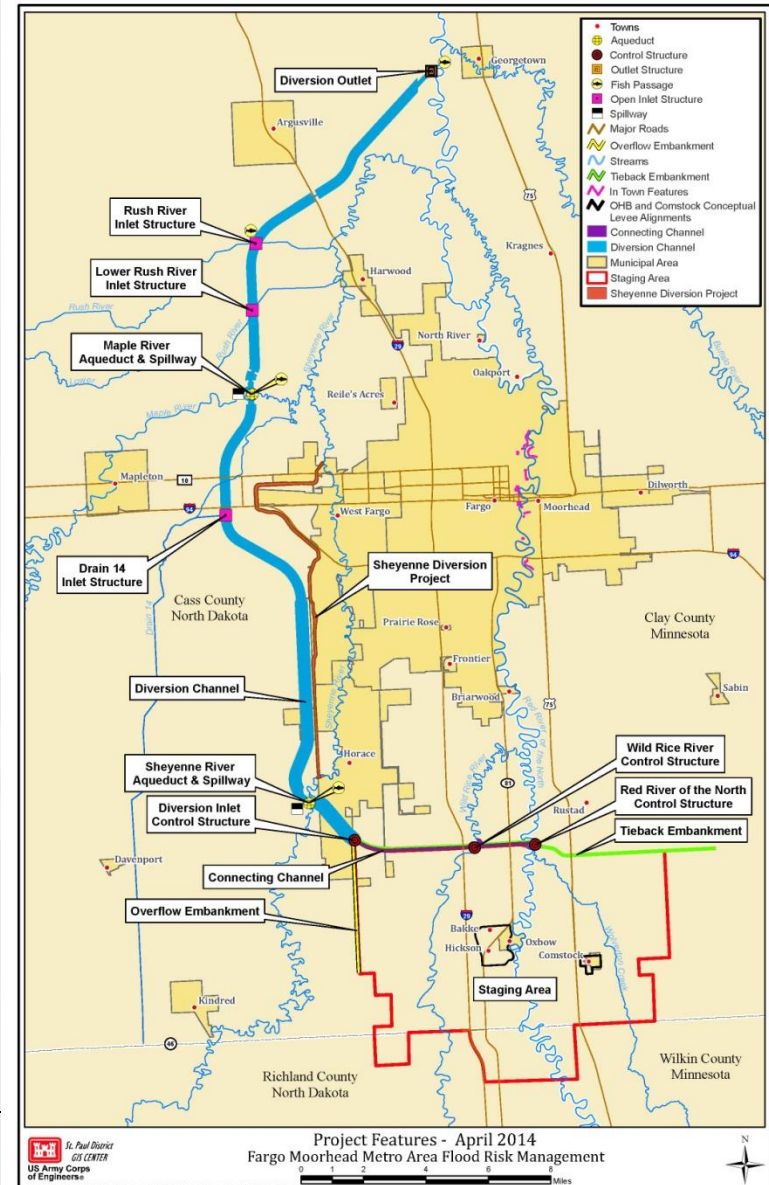

- Assisting with In-Town Levee design and support of construction

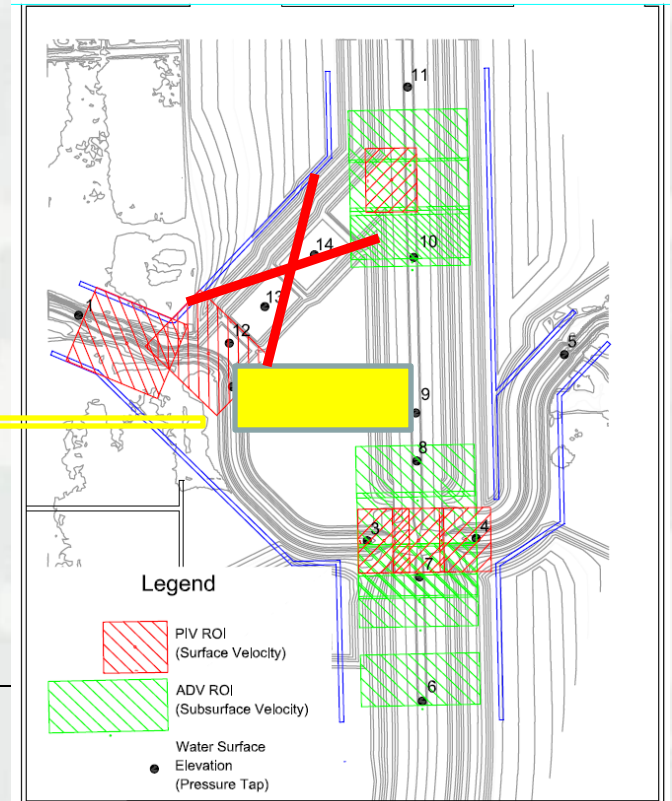


Corps Monthly Update

- Maple River Aqueduct
 - ▶ Updates to the physical model are almost completed
 - Calibration of the model in process
 - ▶ Design team to start development of plans and specifications

- Continued coordination with MN DNR on their EIS process
- Jan 13th - Meet with Governor Mark Dayton (MN) and discussed the FMM project
