## Request for Proposals for Oxbow House Relocation Project

The Cass County Joint Water Resource District (CCJWRD) is seeking Proposals from Developers to relocate 10 flood buyout houses from the existing, older portion of Oxbow into the new, south development in Oxbow. Developer will be responsible for identifying 10 of the 13 candidate houses, purchasing 10 replacement lots, constructing new foundations and site work on the 10 replacement lots, moving the existing flood buyout houses to the new replacement lots, demolishing the existing foundations, and selling the relocated houses for profit.

Proposals for the **Oxbow House Relocation Project** will be received at the office of the Cass County Joint Water Resource District (CCJWRD), 1201 Main Avenue West, West Fargo, ND 58078-1301, until 12:00 p.m. (noon) local time on September 26, 2016.
